BOOK CLOSURE

The Company's share transfer books will be closed from 08 April, 2017 to 14 April 2017 (both days inclusive) to determine the entitlement of final dividend 2016 (Rs. 165.00 i.e. 330.00%) per ordinary share and to determine the entitlement to Attend the Annual General Meeting of the company, scheduled for 14 April, 2017. The share transfer books will be reopen on 15 April, 2017 valid transfers received by the close of business on 07 April, 2017 at the office of the company's Share Registrars M/s THK Associates (Private) Limited, 1st Floor, 40-C, Block-6, P.E.C.H.S Karachi - 75400, will be treated in time for the purpose of payment of the final dividend to the transferees.

Reminder for submission of the photocopy of CNIC / NTN (Mandatory)

The Individual Members who have not yet submitted photocopy of their valid Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC) to the Company / Share Registrar, are once again reminded to send the same at the earliest directly to Company's Share Registrar, M/s THK Associates (Private) Limited, 1st Floor, 40-C, Block-6, P.E.C.H.S, Karachi-75400. The Corporate Entities are requested to provide their National Tax Number (NTN). Please give Folio Number with the copy of CNIC / NTN details. Further, mentioning of CNIC number in the Annual Return "Form A" is also an obligatory requirement, which is required to be filed with SECP under section 156 of the Companies Ordinance 1984.

Submission of the NTN Details (Mandatory)

(i) The Government of Pakistan through Finance Act, 2014 has made certain amendments in Section 150 of the Income Tax Ordinance 2001 whereby different rates are prescribed for deduction of withholding tax on the amount of dividend paid by the Companies. Now these rates as per Finance Act 2016 are as under:

(a)	For Filers of Income Tax Return	12.5%
(b)	For Non-Filers of Income Tax Return	20.0%

To enable the Company to make tax deduction on the amount of cash dividend @ 12.5% instead of 20.0% all the shareholders whose names are not entered into the Active Tax-payers List (ATL) provided on the website of FBR, despite the fact that they are filers, are advised to make sure that their names are entered into ATL before the start of book closure date for entitlement to payment of Dividend i.e. 08 April 2017, otherwise tax on their cash dividend will be deducted @ 20.0% instead of 12.5%.

(ii) The corporate members/shareholders should send a copy of their NTN certificate to the company or it's Share Registrar M/s THK Associates (Private) Limited, if it has not yet been provided. The Shareholders while sending NTN or NTN certificates, as the case may be, must code Company name and their respective folio numbers.

According to clarification received from Federal Board of Revenue (FBR), withholding tax will be determined separately on 'Filer/Non-Filer' status of Principal Shareholder as well as Joint Holder(s) based on their shareholding proportions, in case of joint holding / joint account. In this regard, all shareholders who hold shares with joint shareholders, are requested to provide shareholding proportions of Principal Shareholder and Joint-Holder(s) in respect of shares held by them, to Company's Share Registrar M/s THK Associates (Private) Limited, 1st floor, 40-C, Block-6, P.E.C.H.S, Karachi-75400, in writing, otherwise it will be assumed that the shares are equally held by principal shareholder and joint -Holder(s).

Dividend Mandate (Optional)

According to the SECP circular No. 8(4) SM/CDC 2008 of April 05, 2013, Shareholders are entitled to receive their cash dividend directly in their bank accounts instead of receiving the dividend warrants physically. Shareholders having physical holding and desiring to avail this option may submit the prescribed Dividend Mandate. The dividend mandate form is attached in the Annual Report and is also available on Company's Website.

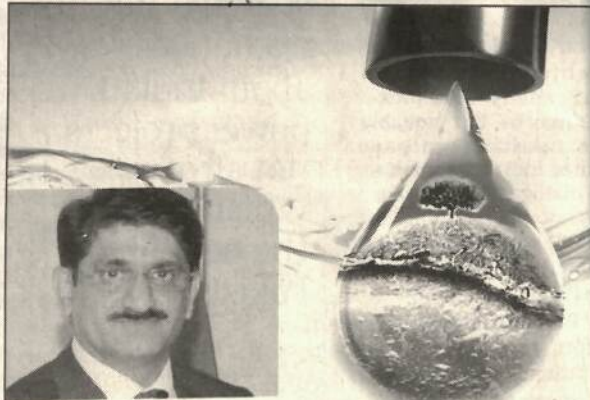
In a rare move, the Punjab Information Commission has asked the Lahore High Court (LHC) to make public the records of salaries, allowances and other perks of its judges and staff on its website.

The commission issued this directive on Tuesday to the LHC registrar to provide information about monthly salary and allowances of the chief justice to the complainant, Sarmad Ali.

The commission asked the registrar to provide this information to the

Punjab Information and Transparency Act, especially in terms of proactive disclosure of salaries, allowances and other perks and privileges of all the judges and staff on the website of the LHC and designation of its public information officers. There is no public information officer at the LHC that is necessary under the provisions of the information act.

The commission further required the LHC to establish an efficient mechanism to decide all
